

HOW YOUR MEMBERSHIP WORKS

1. What the Club Is

- Craft Cannabis Club is a private, members-only club.
- We do not sell cannabis to the public and we do not operate as a retail “per gram” shop.
- Members collectively fund the cultivation, sourcing and handling of cannabis for their own private, personal use.

2. Your Membership Fees (Two Parts)

Your Membership Fees are made up of two components:

1. Base Monthly Membership Fee

- A fixed, recurring monthly fee.
- Gives you access to:
 - the Clubhouse (our private social space and dispensary), and
 - the Member Portal (our online members’ area).
- This fee helps cover shared costs like premises, staff, cultivation and compliance.

2. Usage-Based Top-Up Fees (Pay-as-You-Go)

- On top of your base fee, you pay top-ups depending on how much cannabis you actually want.
- This happens each time you visit the dispensary or place an order via the Member Portal.
- You tell us how much cannabis you need for your private use; we translate that into a proportional top-up fee and allocate cannabis accordingly.
- This is not a per-gram retail sale. It is your additional contribution towards the Club’s communal cannabis and running costs, based on your personal usage.

3. How Cannabis Allocation Works

- The Club keeps a communal stock of cannabis for Members.
- Your indicative entitlement to cannabis is based on:
 - your Membership Fees (base + top-ups),

- your Membership Tier, and
- your usage, always within legal possession limits and Club policies.
- We cannot guarantee specific strains or quantities at all times – allocations depend on availability, harvest cycles, stock levels and quality control.

4. Legal & Responsible Use

By joining, you agree that you will:

- Use cannabis only for your own private, personal use.
- Not sell, donate, trade or supply Club cannabis to anyone else (this may be a criminal offence).
- Never allow minors (under 18) to access or consume cannabis.
- Keep your cannabis secure and private, and stay within legal possession limits.

The Club may suspend or terminate membership if you breach these rules or Applicable Law.

5. Payments & Changes

- Membership Fees (including top-ups) are payable in advance by debit order, EFT, card or other approved methods.
- If your fees are not paid, the Club may:
 - suspend your access,
 - stop allocations, and/or
 - terminate your membership.
- The Club may adjust fees, tiers or rules from time to time, and will notify Members. If you carry on using the Club after changes are notified, you’re deemed to accept them.

6. Ending Your Membership

- You may cancel your membership by giving one month’s written notice.
- You remain liable for any Membership Fees and charges up to your effective cancellation date.
